

# PATIENT WISH LIST ... A List of Funding Needs for Patient Projects and Programs at the Erie VAMC

<u>VOLUNTEER RECOGNITION</u> (Fund #1001) This fund is used to sustain the Erie VAMC VA Voluntary Service Program by financially supporting volunteer recognition activities and items throughout the year.

GENERAL PATIENT NEEDS (Fund #1002) This fund supports a broad range of ongoing patient programs and projects, including the patient coffee/refreshment program, general patient needs, and comfort items. This fund also supports the other patient general post funds when emergency funding is needed.

HOSPICE (Fund #1003) This fund supports the needs of Hospice inpatients. Donations from this fund are used to support the Erie VAMC Dream-a-Dream Program, which enables our Hospice patients to fulfill a "last wish".

RECREATION (Fund #1004) Funds are needed to support ongoing patient recreation programs, such as bowling, trips/outings, canteen books, and similar programs. Funds are also used to purchase recreation supplies, equipment, and other items needed to run the recreation therapy programs.

SOCIAL WORK (Fund #1005) Funds are needed to provide items for indigent patients, which greatly assist in improving the quality of their lives. The patient's assigned social worker is responsible for coordinating any items the patients may need, i.e., bus tokens. This fund also pays for transportation expenses, when possible, for Veterans who are not eligible for VA to pay for their travel to and from their appointments.

PATIENT HOLIDAY (Fund #1006) Funds are needed to purchase gifts for the residents on Units 4 and 5 during the holiday season. Funds will also be utilized to support holiday parties and special programs for the patients.

<u>VETS CENTER</u> (Fund #1007) Funds are used to support programs and activities for Veteran patients at the Veterans Outreach Center.

<u>VISUAL IMPAIRMENT</u> (Fund #1008) Funds are used to support programs and activities for Veteran patients enrolled in the Visual Impairment Services Team.

TRANSPORTATION (Fund #1012) Funds are being accepted towards the purchase of new vans to transport patients without transportation to their medical appointments at the Medical Center. These vans run on a daily basis and acquire high mileage very fast. Replacement and new vans are needed.

PATIENT HAIRCUTS (Fund #1013) Funds are needed for the Patient Haircut Program. The expense for this is approximately \$250 per month (2 days a month).

WOMEN VETERANS (Fund #1016) Donations in this fund are used to financially support the needs and activities of the Women Veterans Program.

NATIONAL GAMES (Fund #1018) Donations from this fund are used to financially support the hotel and airfare expenses for veteran patients attending the DAV Winter Sports Clinic in Snowmass, Colorado and the National Veterans Wheelchair Games.

HOMELESS VETERANS (Fund #1019) This fund benefits our homeless Veteran patients. Funds from this account will be used to purchase miscellaneous items needed for our homeless Veteran patients.

LIBRARY/PATIENT EDUCATION (Fund #1021) This fund benefits our patient education program by purchasing patient education literature and videos for use through our Library.

<u>CHAPLAIN PROGRAM</u> (Fund #1022) This fund accepts donations for needs of the Chaplain Program.

WELCOME HOME (Fund #1030) Funds from this account are used to financially support any activities and/or supplies needed for the Erie VA Medical Center's annual Welcome Home Veteran Appreciation celebrations. These funds are also used to support any needs of returning Operation Enduring Freedom/Operation Iraqi Freedom Veterans and their families.

HEALTH PROMOTION DISEASE PREVENTION PROGRAM (Fund #1031) Funds from this account are used for activities such as Salute Your Health lecture series, MOVE Weight Management Program, annual health fair, and the VA 2K Walk 'n Roll events.

MY HEALTHE VET PROGRAM (Fund #1032) Funds from this account are used to financially support any activities and/or supplies needed for the Erie VA Medical Center's My Healthe Vet Program.

COMFORT ITEMS The following items are always needed in helping those patients who do not have the necessary comfort items for hospitalization: <a href="mailto:shaving cream">shaving cream</a>, <a href="mailto:denture cleaner">denture cleaner</a>, <a href="plastic disposable razors">plastic disposable razors</a> (no generic brand at least twin blades), <a href="mailto:combs">combs</a>, <a href="mailto:deodorant">deodorant</a>, <a href="mailto:toothpaste">toothbrushes</a>, and <a href="mailto:hand sanitizing lotions">hand sanitizing lotions</a>. It is always extra special when organizations make a project out of this and provide us with the ready-to-go kits. We suggest you use the trial size (personal size) items. Each kit could be a large zip-lock plastic bag or similar plastic bag. The kits may also contain items such as pens, emery boards, shower caps, powder, etc. if you wish. Our current inpatients are in need of baby wipes, hand sanitizers, brand name Kleenex, brand name razors, sketch pads, boxes of assorted occasion cards, large-print word search books, and relaxation music CDs. No cologne, mouth wash, aerosols, bar soap, jigsaw puzzles, paperback books, VHS tapes, or laprobes – please!!
